COMMUNITY COUNCIL CHAIRMAN



Councillor Mike Jones was elected Chairman of the Community Council at the Annual Meeting in May. Councillor Paul Armstrong was elected Vice-Chairman.

A494 (ASTON HILL) IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

The Public Inquiry into the scheme which proposes to substantially widen the A494 Aston Hill has been scheduled to take place on Tuesday 11 September 2007 at the Holiday Inn, Northop Hall.

ADDITIONAL LIGHTING IN

HAWARDEN & MANCOT

The Community Council has agreed to provide additional lighting in Bennett's Lane, Hawarden, Colliery Lane, Mancot and The Nook, Mancot.

YOUTH INITIATIVES

As part of the Council's programme to reward and encourage good citizenship amongst the youth of the Community, various initiatives have been introduced or supported by the Council this year.

* The Hawarden High School Bursary Scheme.

This scheme is intended to provide support to pupils going on to higher and further education. The support is given based on a criteria of demonstrable good citizenship both in the school and the wider community. Four pupils have been recognised with support for their forthcoming studies.

* Support to Youth Clubs

Financial assistance has been given to both Hawarden and Mancot Youth Clubs to fund outings for regular attendees of the respective clubs, as an incentive to youngsters to become regular members.

* Junior Community Council

The Community Council is working alongside various youth organisations including the High School to establish a Junior Community Council. It is hoped that this will be a forum where young people from the community can put their views forward on issues which are important to them.

SUMMER PLAYSCHEMES

The Council is sponsoring the Summer Playschemes for 5-12 Year olds taking place at Gladstone Playing Fields, Level Road, Aston Park, Ewloe Green CP and Mancot Playing Fields commencing on 23 July for five weeks.


Did You Know?
