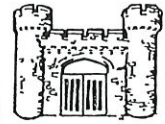

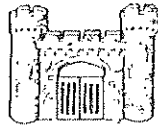

At its meeting on 8th March 2021 (*minute number 133/20 refers*) the community council agreed "to approve the development of a Community Plan, in principle, and that a Community Steering Group be established within six months".

Prior to the establishment of the Steering Group it is recommended that One Voice Wales be asked to provide a bespoke training session on Place Plans at a cost of £399.00 for 20 members. The course will equip the council with all the information required and will provide some tools and techniques for the essential steps. The training session will also provide information about further resources that can be accessed as we develop our own place plan.

It is anticipated that the session can take place week commencing 18th October.
